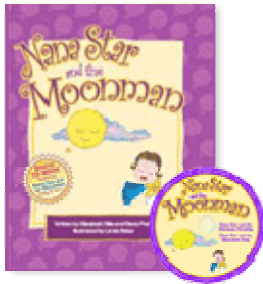


## Nana Star and the Moonman
