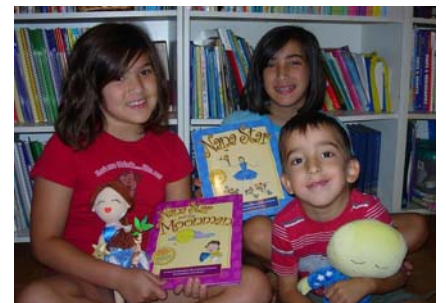
Each book contains vintage-inspired illustrations and old fashioned values and also come with storytime CD with sing-along songs. And my children truly enjoyed the sing-along songs.
